





# Rules and other important info

The ELEPHANT CHARGE is committed to continue supporting local conservation projects. Now, more than ever, our wildlife and the people living and working within national parks need support and protection.

#### GENERAL

Once again this year we ask that teams be self-sufficient in their own campsites. There will be a bar and burgers for sale on the Saturday evening after the CHARGE.

There should be a running river ON SITE this year. However please be sure to bring all your drinking water and some extra.

Please do NOT come to the CHARGE if you are displaying symptoms related to COVID-19.

#### FINE.

It is dry season. The bush is like a tinder box. Light a fire ONLY in your designated camping area, if possible, please use mbaulas or gas stoves. Make sure there is a clear space (foliage free) around your campfire. Do not leave the fire unattended. Put water on the fire if you have to leave it.

Cigarettes are a fire hazard. Please do not throw cigarettes out of the car windows or leave them on the ground they are not biodegradable.

#### GEO TAB FITTING

Geo Tabs will be available for fitting on site from Friday at 11am. If your vehicle has not yet been fitted, please arrive early on Friday to allow plenty of time for a fitting.

The Fuchs Elephant Charge 2023 results will be announced on Saturday evening after the CHARGE, followed by live music from AfroRed!

#### PLEASE REMEMBER...

We are in the wilderness and the mission of Elephant Charge is to protect the extraordinary beauty of this country. Any personal ideas of fun cannot interfere with the environment, which is home to many local communities. If you are in doubt about the guidelines, be sure to ask any Charge Official.

#### CAMPING

Be sure to check in at HQ before setting up your campsite! We do have allocated camping areas, this is to allow space for everyone, so that we are not all camping on top of each other. There is also an entry fee of K100 per vehicle, which is donated to the local community that is hosting us at the site. Please camp in the designated areas only. All campers are expected to be self-sufficient in terms of camping





# LEOPARDS HILL MEMORIAL PARK



LEOPARDS HILL MEMORIAL PARK (LHMP) is a private cemetery offering quality facilities in landscaped and secure grounds, giving a tranquil final resting place for loved ones. Our cemetery has strict design guidelines to ensure the beauty and serenity of the park. Our park is maintained all year round by dedicated professionals who ensure the highest funeral service standards. It is a well-known fact that Zambia has a deep reverence for burial sites and LHMP is a response to the lack of dignified burial grounds. An international joint venture partner once toured the cemetery and commented that they believe that "you can always tell a people by how they look after their dead." Needless to say, they were impressed with both the investment and the attention to detail in implementing this project. LHMP It is a landscaped environment with irrigated lawns and 24-hour security – a fitting setting for the dignified interment of loved ones, Various types of burial sites to suit individual needs are available for reservation.

LHMP offers three different sections across the whole cemetery, namely;

• Lawn Section: These sections are the

majority of sites offered and allow for the erection of a headstone only. The remainder of the grave will be levelled, after the mound has compacted, and planted with grass.

- Memorial Section: These sections allow for the erection of a headstone and a memorial stone over the whole grave.
- Specialised sections: These sections represent the more premium sites and allow the family varying degrees of freedom to design their site to their liking including garden space, the planting of flowers/trees of their choosing.
- Cremation site: These sections allow the family to deposit or bury the cremated remains of their loved ones. The family have a variety of cremation sites to choose from depending on their finish of choice.

Each individual site is carefully planned out and surveyed. This ensures each grave site has a survey marker with a GPS point for purposes of detailed record keeping. Our over 60,000 plots are all managed in our customised cemetery management software that we believe is world class and will change how cemeteries are run.














## Helicopter flights at Elephant Charge 2023


